



IT'S TIME TO BE INSPIRED!

Forgood, together with its valued partners and sponsors, are thrilled to invite YOU to participate in the 5th Annual 2017 Forgood Inspiration Awards, which will be held at Mercedes-Benz Plant Visitors Centre. The breakfast event is planned for **1 June 2017** from 07h00—11h00. **Tickets are R100 each** and will be sold from 27 March 2016 and can be purchased at Vodacom4U Pearce Street.

All Non-Government Organizations, caring groups or individuals are invited to enter your inspirational story on how you are trying to make a difference within your community. If chosen as a finalist, you will have the opportunity to increase your exposure and share what you do every day with 500 attendees! We encourage all faith based organisations, NGO's, businesses and government to get involved.

Four finalists will be selected from all the applications by a panel of independent judges and each finalist will be guaranteed a minimum of R40,000. The most inspirational story, as voted by the attendees of the Awards, will also be awarded a further prize based on the net proceeds of ticket sales for the breakfast (a further possible R40,000, depending on attendance.) Additional surprise awards will be made by corporate sponsors, based on the needs registered by the applicant on the Forgood website www.forgood.co.za.

HOW TO ENTER

Submissions open on the 27 March 2017. Templates for electronic registration can be found at www.linkfm.co.za, www.forgood.co.za or www.inspirationawards.co.za. Please follow the following format for your 2017 Forgood Inspirational Awards electronic entry:

1. Please provide your contact details (Name, Organization, Email, Phone Number)
2. Applicants must register their needs on the Forgood website as part of the application. Enter your organization's profile on the Forgood website at www.forgood.co.za.
3. Write a 150 worded profile that introduces and gives a brief background to your organization or group and what your objectives are.
4. Write a 100 word motivation that tells the judges what you would do with the money and how it would contribute to what you do, should you be one of the four winners.
5. Prepare a 10 slide PowerPoint 15 minute presentation (consisting of text, pictures, video, audio, etc...) that gives us an overview of your organization, what you do, how inspirational your work is and how it affects others.

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Please ensure you highlight:

- The organization
 - Community needs and the solutions you identified
 - Important partnerships which assist you in your work (individuals, corporate, etc...)
 - Challenges and achievements you experience and face on a daily basis
 - Success stories to date
 - Your ultimate vision, goals and objectives
6. Prepare a 3 page script that links the script to the PowerPoint slides (in MS word format) that supports and tells the story of your 10 slide PowerPoint presentation above. (This should equate to a 15 minute presentation.)
7. The submission must be emailed to brad.taylor.c@gmail.com or dropped off at Vodacom4U Pearce Street, Berea by 15:00 25 April 2017. The four finalists will be selected by a panel of independent judges and notified by 15 May 2017.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The independent judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into after the results have been made public.
2. Only the four finalists will be notified. Please check our website or Facebook page for the four finalists, should you not be notified.
3. Previous winners may not be eligible for prizes in the year following being a finalist.
4. No late entries will be permitted after the 25 April 2017 cut off period.
